Guidelines for Monthly Tournaments, The Annual Tournament and The Annual Championship

Translated from the Chinese version by Helen Wang and Steven Lin

Monthly Tournaments

- I. The monthly tournament schedule will be announced in the CCGA yearbook.
- II. The general golf rules and the local rules of the tournament course apply to all monthly tournaments. All plays must be holed out. No gimmes.
- III. The green fee, power cart and sale taxes are the responsibility of each individual golfer.
- IV. If the net scores tie in a tournament, the player with the lowest handicap wins. If the handicaps tie, the player with the lowest strokes from the back nine holes wins. If the back nine-hole scores tie, the more senior player wins. If the ages tie, the winner will be determined by draw.
- V. Any dispute regarding scoring or any other technical questions during the play should be raised to the Discipline Committee when handing in the scorecards after the play. The Discipline Committee has the final rule over such disputes.

VI. Winners and Prizes

Men's & Ladies' Low Gross Champion: Trophy for the winners.
 (Each member only qualifies for one Low Gross win in all of the monthly tournaments, not including the Annual Tournament. The gross score of the winner should not exceed 100 for men and 120 for ladies.)

2. Low Net Champion: Trophy for the winner
 3. Low Net 2nd Place: Trophy for the winner
 4. Low Net 3rd Place: Trophy for the winner
 5. Double Eagle: Trophy for the winner(s)
 6. Eagle: Special prize for the winner(s)

7. Men's & Ladies' Longest Drive: Trophy for the winners 8. Closest to the Hole: Trophy for the winners

(Two contests will be set up for each nine-hole)

9. Hole in One: Trophy for the winner(s)

VII. Guests

- 1. Every CCGA member has the right to invite guests to the tournament provided that prior notice is given to the Chief Executive.
- 2. The Chief Executive is authorized, on a first come first serve basis, to allocate available tee time spots to guests.

- 3. Honourary guests who are invited by the President are not subject to the above two conditions.
- 4. The green fee and drinks of the guest are his/her own responsibility. An additional fee of \$40 will be charged for dinner and lucky draws.
- 5. Guests only qualify for the Closest to the Hole contests, not other prizes.

VIII. Penalties

- 1. Members and guests are responsible for any confirmed tournament green fees. Failure to attend the tournament after confirmation will result in a fine of the same amount as the green fee.
- 2. Every player should report to the registration desk 30 minutes prior to his/her scheduled tee time. Failure to do so will result in a fine of \$10.
- 3. The above fines can be waived on special circumstances with 24 hours prior notice to the Chief Executive and with the final consent of the President. Should the green fee have already been paid to the course and is not refundable, the player is then still obliged for the green fee payment.
- All fines should be paid to the tournament executives on the spot, otherwise the player will be disqualified for any further tournament contests; if the fines are still overdue at the end of year, the player will be deprived of membership status.

<u>Annual Tournament</u>

- The general golf rules and the local rules of the tournament course apply to the annual I. tournament. All plays must be holed out. No gimmes.
- II. Grouping: members will be separated into two groups, ladies and men.
- III. Winners and Prizes

1. Low Gross Champion of each group: Trophy for the winners 2. Low Net Champion: Trophy for the winners 3. Low Net 2nd Place: Trophy for the winners 4. Low Net 3rd Place: Trophy for the winners 5. Double Eagle: Trophy for the winner(s) 6. Eagle: Special prize for the winner(s) Special prize for the winners 7. Longest Drive of each group: 8. Closest to the Hole: Special prize for the winners

(Two contests will be set up for each nine-hole)

9. Hole in One: Trophy for the winner(s)

Annual Overall Championship

I. The Annual Overall Championship is based on the accumulated points from all tournaments according to the following conversion chart. The player with the highest points from his/her best 4 scores of the year wins the Overall Champion title.

- II. Members who are absent from the tournament gain 0 points.

Overall Champion: Trophy for the winner
 2nd Place: Trophy for the winner
 3rd Place: Trophy for the winner
 Full Attendance Prize: One dozen golf balls

5. Special prize for the Chief Executive for the hard work during the year

Note: If there are ties for the above winners, each will be rewarded with one trophy.
